

RESOLUTION No. 159

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, the City Council did, on November 3 1939, pass and adopt Resolution of Intention No. 2380 to discontinue and abandon a tract of land designated as a "PARK" on the "Plat of Swanston Park Unit No. 1", and situated on the southwest corner of 16th Street and Broadway, and which is hereinafter described, and which said resolution set December 8 1939 as the date of hearing and final action thereon, and same having been duly and regularly continued to this date, and

WHEREAS, on this day, April 12 1940, the matter came on regularly for hearing and final action, and no person appearing to protest the said abandonment, and the City Attorney having filed an affidavit of publication and an affidavit of posting, in full accordance with said resolution and the law, and having produced a witness as follows, to-wit: Jas. S. Dean, City Manager, who after being duly sworn, testified:

- That said lot is not appropriate, convenient or necessary for park purposes;
- That same has never been used by the public for park purposes;
- That no consideration has been paid for said lot;
- And that no public funds have been expended to improve said lot as a park, and

The hearing having been closed and the City Council, after having considered the evidence, finds that said lot is not appropriate, convenient or necessary for a park; that same has not been used by the public for park purposes; that no consideration has been paid therefor; and that no public funds have been expended to improve the same as a park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said tract of land be abandoned as a park and for park purposes as provided and authorized by Chapter 1107 of the Statutes of 1939, State of California.

Said tract of land hereinabove abandoned as a park is situate in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north-westerly line of Land Park Drive, of the City of Sacramento, which point is further described as being located N 70° 34' West 45.21 feet; thence S 19° 36.64' West 40.00 feet; thence North 70° 34' West 51.19 feet; thence S 64° 26' West 50.35 feet from a stone monument marking the center line intersection of 16th Street and Broadway, (formerly "Y" Street); thence from the point of beginning S 64° 26' West 133.50 feet to a point; thence N 19° 26' East 120.00 feet; thence S 70° 34' East 83.79 feet; thence by a curve to the right having a radius of 15.00 feet and whose chord bears S 3° 03.71' East 27.71 feet to the point of beginning.
