SUBJECT: PROHIBIT ALL PARKING ON A PORTION OF RIVER PLAZA DRIVE

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

River Plaza Drive from Gateway Oaks Drive east to the end of the cul-de-sac.
Council District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council approve the attached resolution to prohibit all parking on River Plaza Drive east of Gateway Oaks Drive.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends prohibiting all parking on River Plaza Drive from Gateway Oaks Drive east to the end of the cul-de-sac. Prohibiting all parking on this section of River Plaza Drive will make it easier for motorist to enter and exit driveways.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Parking along this section of River Plaza Drive is currently unrestricted.
- Parked vehicles make exiting and entering driveways difficult.
- The owner and manager of the two office properties on River Plaza Drive has requested the removal of all parking.
- There is adequate off-street parking for employees and clients.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.



A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF RIVER PLAZA DRIVE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.01.101 of the Sacramento City Code, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

All parking shall be prohibited on the following street:

- River Plaza Drive, from Gateway Oaks Drive east to the end of the cul-de-sac.

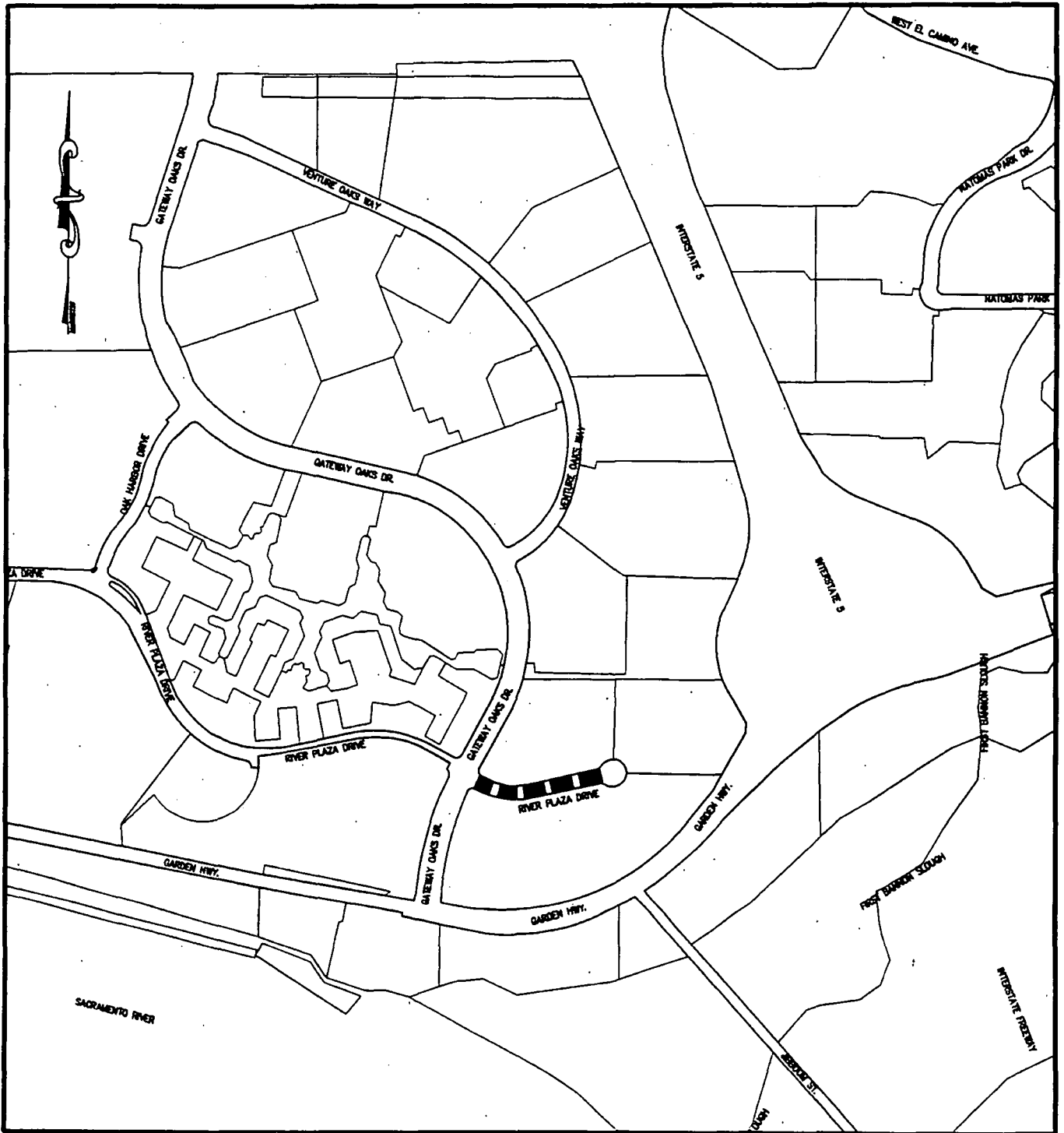
