SUBJECT: C-D and F-G Alleys from 12th to 13th Streets (CC: 9706) - Funds
Appropriation, Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Fund appropriation, approval of the project plans and specifications, and advertising for competitive bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The alleys in the blocks between C and D Streets and F and G Streets, from 12th to 13th Streets, have deteriorated to the point where they must be reconstructed. The sewer lines in those alleys also require reconstruction. The estimated costs of the project are as follows:

Administrative costs	\$ 10,500
Consultant costs	8,000
Construction costs	84,000
Inspections, materials testing, etc.	8,500
Contingencies	<u>5,000</u>
Total	\$116,000

The Budget and Finance Committee considered this appropriation at their meeting of January 7, 1986 with a staff recommendation to approve the appropriation.

FINANCIAL


No funds have been appropriated for this project. The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency has issued an individual project agreement to the City from Tax Increment Funds for this project. It is proposed that the needed funds of \$116,000 be appropriated from the Housing and Redevelopment Agency Capital Improvement Account, which will be fully reimbursed by the agency. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$84,000.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

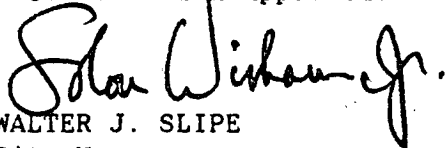
1. Appropriate the needed funds from the Housing and Redevelopment Agency Capital Improvement Account by passage of the attached resolution, and
2. Approve the plans and specifications and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on February 4, 1986.

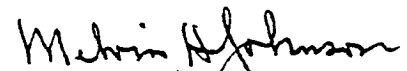

Subject: TRAINING FACILITY CLASSROOMS

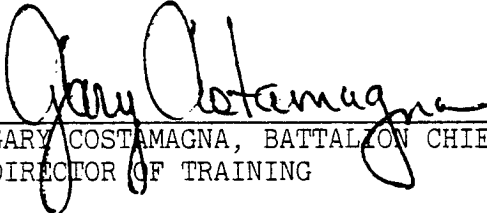
The Division of Training has three classrooms. The capacity of each room is as follows:
