BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City entered into an agreement on October 21, 1997 with Nolte and Associates to prepare preliminary geometrics and utility plans for the Stockton Boulevard/Broadway Intersection Improvement project. The original agreement plus Supplement No. 1 total \$90,940.00. Supplement No. 2 is required to compensate Nolte and Associates for design services due to the following changes:

1. Asphaltic concrete (AC) over modifications.
2. Revisions to the combined sewer/storm system on Stockton Boulevard.
3. Miscellaneous coordination and design modifications related to striping additions and on-site/off-site service coordination.

With Supplement No. 2 the total will be \$107,950.00 requiring City Council approval.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The existing project budget is \$1,218,119 of which \$88,939 remains unobligated as of December 30, 1998. The cost of the additional design services is \$16,650.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

A Negative Declaration was ratified for this project and a Notice of Determination was filed with the County Recorder.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The action requested is consistent with Title 58 of the Sacramento City Code and existing policy regarding agreements for capital improvement projects.


