SUBJECT: Authorization to Submit Grant Proposals to the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency

## SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the City Manager to submit grant proposals to the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency on behalf of the Recreation Division, Department of Parks and Community Services. The two grant proposals are: (1) a volunteer Workreation Teen Diversion Program, and (2) supplementary funding support for the 1984 Summer Food Program.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA) administers federally funded human services programs and requests grant proposals each year for their Community Services Block Grant Program. These two grant proposals from the Recreation Division are in response to that request.

### Volunteer Workreation Teen Diversion Program

This grant proposal is in the amount of \$52,818 and is for a year 'round volunteer Workreation Program to be offered in the River Oaks and New Helvetia Housing projects in cooperation with the Housing and Redevelopment Agency. Patterned after the last two summers' successful Workreation Programs throughout the community, this program will offer employment opportunities, job training, job search training and orientation and recreation activities, as well as teen diversion seminars (drug abuse, pregnancy counseling, etc.) It is anticipated that 60 low-income youth (ages 14-17) will be involved directly in the program and an additional 100 youth involved in the supplementary recreation activities and teen diversion seminars. Participants will perform job tasks in the two housing projects in the areas of maintenance, recreation, child care and general clerical.

Supplementary Funding Support - 1984 Summer Food Program

CETA provided funding to the Recreation Division in the summer of 1983 to supplement the funding from the United States Department of Agriculture to administer, supervise and monitor the Summer Food Program for low-income children. This grant proposal is in the amount of \$14,527, which will provide for the monitoring and clerical staff required to properly manage the 1984 Summer Food Program. The USDA program provides the major funding for the preparation, delivery and overall administration of the program.


FINANCIAL DATA

No additional City funds are required. All costs associated with this program are reimbursed from the grant proposals or the USDA reimbursement. An in-kind match of personnel and supplies totalling \$14,276 is the City's contribution.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize:

1. The City Manager to submit on behalf of the Department of Parks and Community Services, Recreation Division, to the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency two grant proposals as follows:
  - a. Volunteer Workrecreation Teen Diversion Program - \$52,818.
  - b. Supplementary Summer Food Service Program funding - \$14,527.
2. The City Manager to negotiate, approve and sign all contracts related to these program proposals.
