## **Description/Analysis**

**Issue:** The intersection of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street is identified as the top-ranked project on the Traffic Signals Program list in the 2008 Transportation Programming Guide (TPG). The number of collisions and the peak hour volume were major factors in elevating this location to the top of the list. The purpose of this project is to install a traffic signal at the intersection of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street. City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding the construction contract.

This project was advertised and bids were received on October 27, 2010. M&M Electric is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder (see Attachment 1). City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding a construction contract.

**Policy Considerations:** The action requested herein is consistent with the Sacramento City Code, Title 3 and with the City of Sacramento Strategic Plan goals of improving and expanding public safety.

### **Environmental Considerations:**

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):** The Community Development Department has reviewed the proposed action and determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Categorical Exemption – State Class 3 and Section Number 15303(d).

**Sustainability Considerations:** This project is consistent with the City's Sustainability Master Plan. It conforms to the Air Quality Focus Area by improving and optimizing transportation infrastructure.

**Other:** None.

**Commission/Committee Action:** None.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** M&M Electric is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Project funding is sufficient to award the construction contract.

**Financial Considerations:** The current project budget is \$355,000, consisting of local transportation funds. As of November 10, 2010, the 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street Intersection Traffic Signal Project (S15094300) has an unobligated balance of \$265,330, which is sufficient to execute the construction contract with M&M Electric in the amount of \$148,969, pay for City furnished equipment, and cover remaining construction management costs. Excess funds in the amount of \$45,000 are to be transferred from the project to the Major Street Construction Tax Contingency.

**Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD):** All bids submitted met all required bid requirements except for Steiny and Company, Inc., which did not meet the 20% ESBE requirement.

**Background Information:**

The intersection of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street is identified as the top-ranked project on the Traffic Signals Program list in the 2008 Transportation Programming Guide (TPG). The number of collisions and the peak hour volume were major factors in elevating this location to the top of the list. The purpose of this project is to install a traffic signal at the intersection of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street. City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding the construction contract.

This project was advertised and bids were received on October 27, 2010. M&M Electric is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder (see Attachment 1). City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding a construction contract. The bids are summarized below:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$135,000. It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to M&M Electric as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Construction is anticipated to begin in January and be completed by March 2011.

### **APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AND AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 6<sup>th</sup> STREET AND W STREET INTERSECTION TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT (S15094300)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The intersection of 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street is identified as the top-ranked project on the Traffic Signals Program list in the 2008 Transportation Programming Guide.
- B. The project was advertised and a total of five bids were received on October 27, 2010.
- C. Contract award to M&M Electric is recommended as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding the construction contract

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Plans and Specifications for the 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street Intersection Traffic Signal Project (S15094300) are approved.
- Section 2. The construction contract is awarded to M&M Electric in an amount not to exceed \$148,969.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with M&M Electric for an amount not to exceed \$148,969 for the 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street Intersection Traffic Signal Project (S15094300).
- Section 4. Excess funds in the amount of \$45,000 are to be transferred from the 6<sup>th</sup> Street and W Street Intersection Traffic Signal Project (S15094300) to Major Street Construction Tax contingency for future transportation programming.
- Section 5. Exhibit A is incorporated into and made part of this Resolution.
