HEREAS, Sharon Grant, a passerby, had already stopped to assist Mr. Lewis when Chris Darrow drove by on the opposite side of the traffic lanes, and noticing the situation used his cell phone to call 911; and

HEREAS, after administering a glucose test obtained from the vehicle of Sharon Grant it was determined that Mr. Lewis was in a life threatening condition if help did not arrive quickly; and

HEREAS, Chris dialed 911 a couple more times to relay vital information on Mr. Lewis' condition and obtained the necessary data to relay to responding emergency medical staff all the while reassuring Mr. Lewis and never leaving the scene until after the paramedics arrived; and

HEREAS, during this same ordeal Chris once again assisted a stranger by calling AAA for Sharon Grant as she had inadvertently locked her keys in her car during all the excitement, and had to get to her daughter's school to give her own daughter her insulin shot.

Now, THEREFORE, I, Joe Serna, Jr., do hereby commend the humanitarian efforts of Chris Darrow and Sharon Grant as demonstrated by their assisting a citizen in need, and do hereby thank them for taking the time to care for others.
