

ORDINANCE NO. 1047, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1026, FOURTH SERIES, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT DECEMBER 1, 1944," BY ADDING TO THE SUBDIVISION "CRAFTS AND LABOR" A NEW CLASSIFICATION AND SALARIES THEREFOR; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


SECTION 1: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 1026, Fourth Series, is hereby amended by adding to the Subdivision "CRAFTS AND LABOR," the following:


