DONATING SURPLUS EQUIPMENT

BACKGROUND


- A. The Department of General Services, Fleet Management division has received a request from the Sacramento Drowning Accident Rescue Team (DART) to donate two 2001 Dodge Ram trucks and one Polaris Neptune 350 boat and accompanying trailer to support its search and rescue operations. This equipment is surplus to the City's needs and, if not donated, would be offered for sale at public auction.
- B. In accordance with City Code 3.80.030, surplus property may be donated to any charitable organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code by resolution of the City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The donation of two surplus 2001 Dodge Ram trucks (unit numbers 8779 and 9075) and one Polaris Neptune 350 boat and accompanying trailer (unit number 8436) to DART is hereby approved.
