

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0294**

### **Maintenance Agreement Between the City of Sacramento and the County Of Sacramento for Transportation Facilities Along Shared Boundaries**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City and County of Sacramento share numerous boundary lines that travel parallel and typically down the middle of existing roadway infrastructure. The City's jurisdiction is located on one side of the roadway while the County's jurisdiction is located on the other side.
- B. Both agencies agree that a maintenance agreement is necessary to outline responsibilities for maintaining the shared transportation facilities.
- C. The proposed maintenance agreement assigns maintenance and operation responsibilities to the following shared transportation facilities: bridges; guardrail; pavement; curb, gutter and sidewalk; roadside drainage ditches and cross-culverts; landscape, traffic signs; traffic striping and markings; traffic signals; and street lights.
- D. The maintenance agreement assigns maintenance responsibility of assets to each agency in a fair and equitable manner.
- E. The agreement is structured so no funds are transferred between the agencies for performing maintenance based on a balanced share of work.
- F. A separate agreement is required for all work performed on shared transportation facilities that affect both agencies and fall outside the scope of maintenance and operation of this agreement.
- G. The County of Sacramento Board of Supervisors approved the Maintenance Agreement on April 9, 2019.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to execute the Maintenance Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the County of Sacramento for the maintenance of transportation facilities along shared boundaries.
