**RESOLUTION OF THE SACRAMENTO HOUSING AND  
REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING THE SIXTH AMENDMENT  
TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN PREPARED FOR THE ALKALI  
FLAT REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento ("City Council") established the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") for the City of Sacramento ("City"), and;

WHEREAS, on November February 10, 1972, the City Council by Ordinance No. 3086 adopted the Redevelopment Plan ("Original Plan") for the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Project ("Project"), and;

WHEREAS, the City Council has since adopted five amendments to the Original Plan for the Project ("Plan"), which occurred on August 12, 1980, by Ordinance No. 4403; on July 17, 1984, by Ordinance No. 84-073; on November 18, 1986, by Ordinance No. 86-109; on July 17, 1990, by Ordinance No. 90-036; and on October 4, 1994 by Ordinance No. 94-046, and;

WHEREAS, the Agency has prepared the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Plan ("Sixth Amendment") which (1) extends the time limits of debt establishment, debt repayment, plan duration, and the exercise of eminent domain authority and (2) increases the tax increment and bond debt limits, and;

WHEREAS, the Sixth Amendment when adopted will replace and supercede the existing Plan, and;

WHEREAS, the Agency caused to be prepared and approved a Negative Declaration for the Sixth Amendment pursuant to Section 15074 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice duly given, a full and fair public hearing has been held on the Sixth Amendment, and the Agency has considered all written and all oral comments and testimony relating thereto and has been fully advised thereon, and;

WHEREAS, the Agency has caused to be prepared and has reviewed a Report to the City Council on the Sixth Amendment pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33352, and;

WHEREAS, the Agency has taken all other actions required by law to prepare and present the Sixth Amendment.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:
