SUBJECT: Report on Bids for Fire Hydrant Installation - U. C. Medical Center

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer recommends that this report be filed pending recommendation of bid award at a later date.

BACKGROUND:

On June 16, 1981 the City Council approved plans and specifications for Fire Hydrant Installation - U. C. Medical Center and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on July 14, 1981. The bids received are as follows:
