RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY
UNDER "SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND
MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2560

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection therewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving the Alley between X and Broadway from the easterly line of 18th Street to the westerly line of 19th Street, by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; installing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; reconstructing existing manhole by placing curb and cover to proper grade; grading and constructing a hydraulic concrete pavement, six inches in thickness.

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 6289 of Mission Trecho Subdivision (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) and proceeding easterly along the northline of Lots #6289, #6290, #6291, and #6292 of said tract which adjoins the southerly boundary of X Street to the northeast corner of said lot #6292; then southerly to the

thence southerly along the easterly boundary of Lot 6292 to the northwest corner of Lot 6295 of said tract; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Lot 6295 to the northeast corner thereof to the westerly boundary of 19th Street; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of 19th Street to the southeast corner of Lot # 6297 of said tract; thence westerly along the southerly boundary of Lot# 6297 and Lot #6301 in a straight line to the southwest corner of said Lot # 6301 which joins the easterly boundary of 18th Street; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of 18th Street to the northwest corner of Lot# 6288 of said tract; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of Lot # 6288 to the northeast corner of said Lot #6288 which joins Lot #6289 of said tract; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Lot # 6289 to the point of beginning.

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is nil.

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; with bonds to be issued as authorized under the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," approved June 11, 1915, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Section 3 of the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931," approved June 8, 1931, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.
