SUBJECT: DONATION OF SURPLUS CITY KRANE KAR TO THE HAYES TRUCK MUSEUM

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT: City-wide

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

The Procurement Services Division, on behalf of the Fleet Operations Group in the Department of Public Works, recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolution authorizing donation of a surplus City Krane Kar (Equipment No. 0662) to the Hayes Truck Museum in Woodland, for preservation and inclusion in their collection of historical vehicles.

SUMMARY:

The Fleet Operations Group has received a request from the Hayes Truck Museum in Woodland, asking that the City donate a surplus City Krane Kar (Equipment No. 0662) to the Hayes Truck Museum, for preservation and inclusion in their collection of historical vehicles.

BACKGROUND:

The Fleet Operations Group has received a request for the City to donate a surplus City Krane Kar to the Hayes Truck Museum. The Fleet Operations Group supports the recommendation that the Krane Kar be donated to the Hayes Truck Museum.

The subject vehicle is a 1941 Krane Kar, a tug-type vehicle with a fixed crane boom, which was formerly used at the City Corporation Yard to lift and move heavy items. It has been stored unused at the Corporation Yard for several years, and is surplus to the City's needs. The normal method of disposition for such equipment is sale by public auction, and it is anticipated that the sale of the subject vehicle would likely

yield less than \$100.00. Alternatively, the vehicle is representative of the history of trucks and related heavy equipment, and would complement other vehicular equipment that has been gathered by the Hayes Truck Museum for their museum collection.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The book value of the subject Krane Kar is less than \$100.00 and, if it were sold at public auction, it would be expected to yield less than \$100.00. Because of its age and somewhat unique design, its value to the Hayes Truck Museum is measured in historical value rather than in monetary terms. The Hayes Truck Museum depends on donations to preserve trucks and related vehicles so that the contribution of such vehicles to our society and economy may be enjoyed by local citizens for years to come.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Sacramento City Code § 12.05.131(F) authorizes donation of surplus City property to other public agencies or charitable organizations exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, by resolution of the City Council. The Hayes Truck Museum has stated that they are a non-profit organization and are tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

This proposed donation is consistent with the Council's policy of working both locally and regionally for community betterment and to preserve items of interest to citizens of the Sacramento region.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Ongoing administrative and maintenance activities, which are not part of a public works construction project, do not constitute a "project" and are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15061(b)(1), 15378(b)(3).

ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

Because this transaction does not involve the purchase of goods or services for the City, EBE/SBE efforts are not applicable.
