For a very general budget: 10 rooms at \$84/night (government rate-lowest of rates to be offered) = \$840.
With \$50 housekeeping, \$50 desk-check-in & out..., \$100 supplies- cleaning, linens, toilet paper, \$100 maintenance, \$50 miscellaneous, \$240 mortgage/home equity, \$250 donate to non-profits. For 30 days/month at 100% occupancy = \$7,500+ donations per month, 80% = \$6,000+ per month and 50% = \$3,750+ per month

The Time Has Come... A Green project that visually displays what items look like...

A touchable "Extreme Makeover" that one can look in on over and over... Tomorrow's museums that one can try out

1. A hands-on concept house were one may try out building/remodeling possibilities and technology's latest and greatest: A taste of the past & the latest in informatics technology
 - have an open house to the public during second Saturday at least 10 of the months of the year, so people can see possibilities for remodeling and building that are handicap accessible, green and healthy - as more baby boomers age - remodeling now may help more stay out of more expensive, unaffordable assisted and nursing home style living
 - have Friday, Saturday, Sunday overnight stays be an opportunity to try out remodeling and building possibilities (and raise more money for non-profit organizations than weeknights)[cleaner air, radiant heating, skylights, tankless water heaters, handicap bars, walk-in showers, lift, computers/monitors/software/peripherals-ultimate office]
 - have an 1870's period weekend once a month at least 10 of the months of the year (super fund raiser weekends) - other period weekend fundraiser possibilities
2. Use the house at night for overnight stays and during the day as office space
 - have state rates - cater to state/government staff Monday - Thursday nights, with use time 5:15 pm through 7:45 am
 - have at least \$5 of each nights stay go toward Sacramento Habitat for Humanity
 - have at least \$5 of each nights stay go toward Foodlink - food for the hungry
 - have at least \$5 of each nights stay go toward reducing domestic violence - prevention and eliminating violence, counseling, nights stay at a safe house
 - have at least \$5 of each nights stay go toward improving health - prevention efforts for heart disease, obesity, diabetes, asthma, ...
 - A location for smaller community meetings and gatherings...
 - Have small restaurant on first floor, have energy/environment workshop in carriage
 - have the property available for classes by Sacramento city planning/building staff to share how something can be correctly done - a design house - in it's truest form
3. A commitment to preserve the past indefinitely...
 - take a 1750 square foot duplex and turn it into a Victorian of almost 5000 square foot duplex with attached carriage garage - eight - ten bedrooms on the 2nd and 3rd floors (4-5 per floor)
 - maintain the Victorian grandeur of the current 2nd floor on all the new, including outside
 - Laura Wells, an elementary school teacher and then principal, owned house in 1878!
