RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 4081

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

APRIL 10TH, 1969

VACATING PUBLIC EASEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 50430 TO 50445 INCLUSIVE OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento has received a petition requesting the vacation of an easement for light and air in the subdivision known as South Land Park Terrace, said vacation to change the setback line from 25 feet to 17 feet in Lot 100 of said South Land Park Terrace abutting Lucas Court.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said Council hereby declares its intention to vacate and abandon the public easement for light and air described as follows:

The Northerly 8 feet of the 25 foot setback in Lot 100, as shown on the Plat of South Land Park Terrace, recorded in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder on the the 13th day of March, 1947, in Book 25 of Maps, Map No. 26, Excepting Therefrom that portion of the 25 foot set back in said Lot 100 on Moss Drive between South Land Park Drive and Lucas Court.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED THAT the 1st day of May, 1969, at the hour of 7:45 o'clock p.m., in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in the City Hall on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets in said City, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the hearing of the proposed vacation of said right of way and easement above described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be directed to publish Notice of Hearing of the proposed vacation of said public easement in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law, and that said Notice be posted along said easement to be vacated, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 50440 and 50441, of the Government Code of the State of California
