**RESOLUTION REGARDING A VOTER REGISTRATION PROGRAM
IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO**

WHEREAS, among the cherished rights of citizens of the United States of America is the right to cast their vote for the person and party of their choice in elections to political office; and

WHEREAS, in the words of George Jean Nathan, "Bad officials are elected by good citizens who do not vote;" and

WHEREAS, it is important for every elected official to help urge citizens to register to vote and to exercise their right to express their preferences in any election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Sacramento, the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento and the staff are directed to develop and implement for every election a voter registration program.
