Dear Sirs:

I am requesting time be set aside, by the Sacramento City Council, to hear my input regarding the adoption of the Ordinance adding Chapter 11.28 to the Sacramento County Code Prescribing Noise Standards for Aircraft at Sacramento Executive Airport. I was in New Hampshire on September 15, when I was informed this issue was on the September 16, 1980 Board of Supervisors' agenda. I am relieved this issue was placed on continuance until September 25. If I had been notified this ordinance was before the Board of Supervisors for adoption, I would have made this request on a more timely basis.

System Integrators, Inc., is a rapidly growing Sacramento company which employs approximately 200 people. We design, manufacture, and install computer systems for newspaper publishing companies nationwide. Our Company currently owns two Lear jets which fly into Sacramento Executive Airport several times a month to transport our employees to various customer locations throughout the country. This ordinance will prevent our Company from utilizing our own airport.

SII is concerned with the noise levels of our aircraft. As a result, our flight crew implement conservative noise abatement procedures when arriving and departing from Executive Airport. Because of these procedures, the noise level is considerably less than described by the FAA in their Analysis of Airplanes for our two models of aircraft.


