**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF UTILITY RELOCATION AND REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT
WITH PG&E FOR POWER INN ROAD WIDENING PROJECT (PN:TK11)**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Power Inn Road Widening from Folsom Boulevard to 14th Street. Council District 6. (See map – Attachment A).

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Approve the Utility Relocation and Reimbursement Agreement with PG&E for relocation of their facilities.

SUMMARY:

Approval of the Utility Relocation and Reimbursement Agreement with PG&E is required to reimburse them for relocation of eight (8) existing steel towers on the east side of Power Inn Road from Belvedere Avenue to the LRT Grade Separation. PG&E signed the agreement and returned it to City staff in late 2000. An agreement is typically approved by both parties prior to PG&E starting the relocation work. However, due to our inadvertent oversight the agreement has not been approved by the City. Nonetheless, PG&E has completed the work as planned and total cost of the work is \$580,000.
