SUBJECT: Fee Amendment Relating to Waste Removal Other Than Residential
(Commercial) Can Rates

SUMMARY

Fee increases for commercial can service are recommended for approval. The proposed increases were reviewed by the Council's Budget and Finance Committee at its April 15, 1980 meeting.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On April 15, 1980 the Budget and Finance Committee reviewed proposed Waste Removal fee increases of 16% for other than residential (commercial) garbage collection. These fees included increases for both bins and garbage cans. The fee increases for commercial garbage can collection were inadvertently omitted from the fees report presented to the Budget and Finance Committee and the City Council on May 27, 1980 (See attached ordinance).

FINANCIAL DATA

The requisite fee increases are necessary to insure that the commercial can collection rates are compatible with the cost of collection.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the fee amended Waste Removal ordinance and its associated fee increases be approved by the Council with these fees to become effective July 1, 1980.





ORDINANCE NO. ~~4370~~ FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 19 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND DECLARING SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT JULY 1, 1980

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3.

Section 19.109 of Chapter 19 of the Sacramento City Code be amended to read as follows:
