

# RESOLUTION No. 720

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That California Packing Corporation be, and it is hereby, granted a revocable permit to construct a box conveyor across "P" Street, between Front and Second Streets, at a point approximately 10 feet east of the east line of the alley; said conveyor to be elevated not less than 21 feet above the center of "P" Street at the point of crossing and to be used for the purpose of conveying empty boxes from the packing plant on the south side of "P" Street to a truck loading plant on the north side of "P" Street.

Said construction, as to location, manner of construction, and maintenance, shall be under the direction of the City Engineer.

This permit is granted upon the further condition that said corporation shall protect and save harmless the City of Sacramento from all damage, costs, and causes of action which might arise from said construction, or operation thereof.

This permit is granted in pursuance of application heretofore made by said corporation.
