

RESOLUTION COMBINING PROCEEDINGS  
INITIATED UNDER NOS. 3833 AND 3834

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that  
Petition approved by Council on September 23rd, 1965, and Resolution  
No. 3833, Waiving Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code of  
the State of California, approved by Council on September 23rd,  
1965, for the construction of a water distribution system, com-  
plete with all necessary appurtenances, in the Easterly one-half  
of Northgate Boulevard from the Westerly production of the North-  
erly line of Lot 82 of Gardena Park (as the same is recorded in  
the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to a point located  
330 feet North of the center line of Senator Avenue; Senator  
Avenue from the center line of Northgate Boulevard to the Easterly  
Boundary of Gardena Park Unit No. 2 (as the same is recorded in  
the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); Natoma Street from  
the Easterly production of the Northerly line of Lot 16 to the  
Easterly production of the Southerly line of Lot 17 of said Gardena  
Park Unit No. 2, designated as Senator Avenue Water Assessment  
District; and

Petition approved by Council on September 30th, 1965, and  
Resolution No. 3834, Waiving Division 4 of the Streets and High-  
ways Code of the State of California, approved on September 30th,  
1965, for the construction of a water distribution system, com-  
plete with all necessary appurtenances, in Tenaya Avenue from the  
center line of Northgate Boulevard to the center line of Natoma  
Street; Natoma Street from the Easterly production of the Northerly  
line of Lot 56 of Gardena Park No. 2 (as the same is recorded in  
the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to the Easterly  
production of the Southerly line of Lot 57 of said Gardena Park  
No. 2, be, and the same are hereby combined; and
