Title: Contract Amendment for Gail Ervin Consulting Services

Description/Analysis

Issue: After a formal solicitation process, the City entered into a consultant and professional services agreement with Gail Ervin Consulting (GEC) in December 2005 to provide environmental services for a project proposed for the 800 block of K and L Streets. The original contract was for preparation of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for a not-to-exceed amount of \$99,985.50. During the public comment period for the Draft EIR (DEIR), a 56-page comment letter has been received, which disputes several findings in the DEIR. The extensive comments will require GEC to coordinate responses with several City departments, City consultants, outside agencies, as well as outside legal counsel. In addition, there was more analysis required and extra printing costs for an exceptionally large Final EIR. An additional fifty (50) hours of work was required to finalize the document.

Policy Considerations: The work completed under the contract provides significant environmental documentation for a future development project on the blighted 800 block of K and L Streets.


Environmental Considerations: The proposed action is not subject to CEQA.

Rationale for Recommendation: The extensive amount of coordination and

additional analysis conducted by GEC was necessary to thoroughly address the comments submitted as part of the public comment period for the DEIR.

Financial Considerations: The total additional fee for services provided under Amendment No. 1 of City Manager Agreement #2005-1219 shall not exceed \$4,900. The total contract amount including this amendment is \$104,885.50. Funds are available in Economic Development's existing professional services budget.

**FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES WITH
GAIL ERVIN CONSULTING SERVICES**

BACKGROUND

- A. After a competitive selection process, the City entered into a Consulting and Professional Services Agreement #2005-1219 with Gail Ervin Consulting (GEC) to prepare an Environmental Impact Report for the 800 K/L project for a not-to-exceed amount of \$99,985.50.
- B. At the time, it was not anticipated that an extraordinary amount of time would be needed for GEC to coordinate responses to particularly extensive comments received during the public comment period for the Draft Environmental Impact Report.

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement Number 1 to City Agreement No. 2005-1219 for environmental services with Gail Ervin Consulting Services increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$4,900 for a total contract amount of \$104,855.50.
