

RESOLUTION No. 211

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

August 22, 1929

WHEREAS, the People of the City of Sacramento having used, during the past few years, the American River Beach near the H Street Bridge for swimming and picnic purposes; and

WHEREAS, there having been many unfortunate drownings due to the inadequate bathing facilities and dangerous condition of the American River; and

WHEREAS, MR. E. CLEMENS HORST having allowed the People of the City of Sacramento the free use of a portion of his property as a right-of-way to and from the bathing beach which also fronts his property, in order that the City and County of Sacramento could provide the necessary safe-guards and to create a bathing beach which would be safe for public use during the hot summer months;

WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Sacramento extend to MR. E. CLEMENS HORST a unanimous vote of thanks for his kind and considerate action to the People of the City of Sacramento.
