

RESOLUTION NO. 2142

RESOLUTION DECLARING FORFEITED BOND FILED BY P. J. O'SHAUGHNESSY IN CONNECTION WITH HIS BID FOR DOING THE WORK PROVIDED FOR UNDER RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2142, AND RESOLUTION ORDERING WORK, PASSED PURSUANT TO SAID RESOLUTION OF INTENTION, AND REQUIRING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COLLECT THE AMOUNT OF SAID BOND FROM THE AMERICAN SURETY COMPANY OF NEW YORK, THE MAKER THEREOF.

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice inviting bids for the installation of a street lighting system on San Miguel Way, from "D" to "H" Streets, pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 2142, and Resolution ordering work, passed pursuant to said resolution of intention on January 20th, 1927, P. J. O'SHAUGHNESSY filed a bid with the City Council for the doing of said work and accompanied said bid with a bond of the American Surety Company of New York in the sum of \$500.00, conditioned that the bidder would enter into a contract for the doing of said work and would execute bond or bonds to the satisfaction of the City of Sacramento, conditioned for the faithful performance of said work; and

WHEREAS, on February 10th, 1927, the City Council passed a resolution of award, awarding the said contract to the said P. J. O'Shaughnessy, he being the lowest bidder for the doing of said work; and

WHEREAS, the notice of said award was duly advertised pursuant to law, the first publication of said notice beginning on February 13th, 1927; and

WHEREAS, more than twenty-five days has past since the first publication of said award has been made, and the said


F. J. O'Shaughnessy, the successful bidder for the doing of said work, has failed and refused to enter into a contract with the City of Sacramento for the doing of said work,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


That the bond of the American Surety Company of New York, above referred to, be, and the same is hereby forfeited to the City of Sacramento, and the City Attorney is hereby instructed to collect the amount of said bond from the said American Surety Company of New York, so that the same may be paid into the General Fund of the City of Sacramento as required by law.
