Subject: Contract: Del Paso Boulevard Street Lighting Replacement Project (PN: SI51 and PN: TX76) - Approve Plans and Specifications, Accept Bids, Award Contract

Recommendation:

Adopt a Resolution: 1) approving the plans and specifications for the Del Paso Boulevard Street Lighting Replacement Project (PN: SI51 and PN: TX76), 2) awarding the construction contract to Adesta Management Group, and 3) authorizing and directing the City Manager to execute the contract in the amount of \$718,868 (PN: SI51 - \$398,868 and PN: TX76 - \$320,000) with Adesta Management Group.

Summary:

The improvements include the replacement of existing streetlights and installation of new streetlights on Del Paso Boulevard from Globe Avenue to El Camino Avenue; installation of communication conduits on Del Paso Boulevard from Arden Way to El Camino Avenue; and, installation of landscape lighting infrastructure on Del Paso Boulevard from Arden Way to El Camino Avenue.

Committee/Commission Action: None.

Background Information:

The existing streetlights have reached the end of their useful life and need replacement. The project will include replacement of existing streetlights and installation of new streetlights on Del Paso Boulevard between Globe Avenue and El Camino Avenue to improve pedestrian safety, promote neighborhood revitalization, and infill development. Also, this project will replace existing deteriorated streetlights with new streetlights on Del Paso Boulevard between Arden Way and El Camino Avenue, install electrical infrastructure for the center median landscape lighting on Del Paso Boulevard between Arden Way and El Camino Avenue, and install communication conduits on Del Paso Boulevard from Arden Way to El Camino Avenue.

This project was originally advertised on November 2, 2005. Four bids were determined to be non-responsive, and one bid was 58% over the engineer's estimate. On December 13, 2005, Council approved the rejection of bids.

This project was re-advertised on January 4, 2006 and new bids were received on February 8, 2006. The results are summarized below:

The engineer's construction estimate was \$725,000.

Staff recommends awarding the contract to Adesta Management Group.

Financial Considerations:

The construction contract with Adesta Management Group in the amount of \$718,868 will be encumbered under two projects: \$398,868 from the Del Paso Boulevard Street Lighting Replacement Project (PN: SI51) and \$320,000 from the Del Paso Streetscape Project - SR160 to Lampasas Avenue Project (PN: TX76). As of March 29, 2006, the Del Paso Boulevard Street Lighting Replacement Project (PN: SI51) has an unobligated balance of \$728,411 and the Del Paso Streetscape Project - SR160 to Lampasas Avenue Project (PN: TX76) has an unobligated balance of \$408,469 which is sufficient to award the construction contract.

Environmental Considerations:

The Environmental Services Manager has reviewed the proposed action and determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(a), 15302(c), and

15303(d) of the CEQA Guidelines. Projects exempted under Class 1, Section 15301(a), 15302(c), and 15303(d) consists of the replacement, repair or minor alteration of existing streets and highways.


Policy Considerations:


This action is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan goals to improve and expand public safety and to achieve sustainability and enhance livability.

M/WBE CONSIDERATIONS:

This project has federal Community Development Block Grant funding and requires conformance with project participation guidelines for Minority/Woman Business Enterprise (M/WBE) in lieu of the City of Sacramento Emerging and Small Business Enterprise (ESBE) program requirements.

Under M/WBE program, the Contractor is required to demonstrate Good Faith Effort (GFE) in documentation of its outreach effort to engage project participation from certified M/WBE subcontractors. Adesta Management Group has satisfactorily demonstrated this effort. M/WBE subcontractor participation for this project is 2.1%.
