

Sacramento, California,

May 22, 1930.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 4:30 o'clock P. M. in their office, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Maloney, Weisman and Chenu.
ABSENT : None.

The minutes of the special meetings of April 7, 1930, and May 5, 1930, were read and approved as read.

Commissioner Chenu relinquished the chair to Commissioner Weisman. Commissioner Chenu moved that the name of H. W. Culbertson be removed from the eligible list due to the fact that Mr. Culbertson had no Civil Service standing having resigned, and due to the fact that we have an opinion from the City Attorney stating that Mr. Culbertson made a statement that he had resigned. Commissioner Chenu withdrew this motion.

Commissioner Maloney moved that the previous action of this Board as of April 7, 1930, relative to H. W. Culbertson be rescinded. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu. Mr. Russell, appearing before the Board in behalf of Mr. Culbertson, was recognized by the Chair and explained at length concerning reports submitted in this case by Mr. Bottoroff and Mr. Evans, and appealed to the Board for consideration on the basis that these reports were technically wrong in that they did not express the thought that they were intended to convey in view of the letter and statement later submitted by Mr. Bottoroff and Mr. Evans and contradictory. Mr. Russell was excused at his request. The case was further discussed by the Board. Commissioner Chenu called for the reading of the motion before the Board. The Secretary

was instructed to call the roll. The vote was as follows:

AYES: Commissioners Maloney and Chenu.
NOES: Commissioner Weisman.

Commissioner Weisman relinquished the Chair to Commissioner Chenu.

The amendment to Rule 8, Section 1, spread upon the minutes of the meeting of May 5, 1930, was discussed by the Board. Commissioner Maloney moved the adoption of the amendment. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weisman. The vote was as follows:


AYES: Commissioners Maloney, Weisman and Chenu.
