**CITY HALL EXPANSION PROJECT (PN: BB81) – APPROVE NAMING OF THE PLAZA**

**Whereas**, the archeological discoveries at the City Hall site have confirmed that the area occupied by the historic and new City Hall buildings was inhabited by Native Americans;


**Whereas**, the artifacts recovered from this site are of significant historical importance and dating of these discoveries indicates that the City Hall site has been a center of cultural activities for the region for over 8,000 years;

**Whereas**, it is appropriate to honor the cultural significance of this site; and,

**Whereas**, "Sa'Cumn'e" means Big House in the Miwok language and this name or similar derivation has historically been used to refer to the area of Cesar Chavez Plaza - City Hall.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

- The Plaza located between the historic and new City Hall buildings be named "Sa'Cumn'e Plaza" to honor the Native American cultural significance of the site.
- A plaque describing the significance of the site shall be located within this Plaza.
