SUMMARY

The Fleet Management Division has a requirement for the purchase of one (1) replacement parking lot sweeper to be utilized by the Parking Division.

BACKGROUND

On February 5, 1985, bids were opened for two (2) Mall/Parking Lot type sweepers. Three (3) bids were received. After extensive evaluation of all three (3) sweepers bid, staff recommended the purchase of the Tennant Model 360, based on its overall performance, parts availability, maneuverability, ease of maintenance, and user acceptance and comfort. (See Exhibit I)

On April 2, 1985, Council approved the purchase of two (2) Model 360 sweepers from the Tennant Company at a cost of \$24,797.66 each, which was more than the other bids received. Since the new sweepers were placed in service in May 1985, the City has experienced excellent service and eliminated the downtime that had been experienced with the previous sweepers.

The 1985-86 Fleet Management Replacement Budget has another sweeper, Equipment No. 4834, due for replacement. The Tennant Company has provided another proposal of \$24,756.22 for this additional sweeper, with delivery within four (4) to six (6) weeks. The purchase of this replacement sweeper with a Tennant Model 360 will enable the City to standardize its parking lot sweepers.

Based on this favorable quotation in comparison to the bids received six (6) months ago and the extensive evaluation that was conducted, it is recommended that the City accept Tennant's proposal for one parking lot sweeper.


FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for this requirement is \$24,756.22. Sufficient funds are available in the Fleet Management Division's current 1985-86 Fiscal Year Replacement Budget.


RECOMMENDATION
