RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION REQUESTING THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS FOR FORMATION OF THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

The City Council of the City of Sacramento Resolves:

The City Council ("the Council") of the City of Sacramento (the "City") together with the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of the County of Sacramento (the "County") have created the Sacramento Regional County Solid Waste Authority for the purpose of:

(a) creating an interim structure prior to the adoption of state legislation permitting the creation of the Sacramento Regional County Solid Waste District as a separate and permanent political entity;

(b) providing a unified and coordinated solid waste management system for the City and the County, including efficient facility and program planning and development and comprehensive and cost-effective solid waste management services;

(c) demonstrating a commitment to, and facilitation of, the development of the most efficient and cost-effective strategies for source reduction, achieving recycling goals, expanding composting and encouraging the establishment of markets for recycled products and recycling industries.

(d) State legislation has been enacted which creates the Sacramento Regional County Solid Waste Management District (the "District") on July 1, 1994, if formation of the District has been approved prior to July 1, 1994, by the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) in accordance with the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act of 1985 (Division I commencing with Section 56000 of Title 6 of the Government Code) following the submittal of a resolution of application by the County and the City.

For the purpose of complying with the aforementioned legislation, the Council makes the following declarations:

1. It is the intent of this Council that all of the area within the boundaries of the City be included within the jurisdiction of the District.

2. LAFCo is hereby requested to take proceedings in regard to the formation of the District, the boundaries of which are to be coextensive with those of the City and of the unincorporated area of the County.

3. LAFCo is requested to condition the formation of the District as follows:

(a) The name of the District shall be the Sacramento Regional County Solid Waste Management District.

(b) The District shall have the powers and perform the functions set forth in Division 32 (commencing with Section 60000) of the Public Resources Code.

(c) The effective date of the formation of the District shall be July 1, 1994.

4. Bob Thomas, Deputy City Manager whose mailing address is 915 "I" Street, Room 101, Sacramento, California 95814, is designated as the person to be furnished all notices and reports pertaining to this application.


5. The County of Sacramento and the City of Sacramento are the Counties, Cities and Districts affected by the proposal.
