

ORDINANCE NO. 1581, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND HAVE THE CONSTRUCTION WORK OF BUILDING A PEN FOR THE GIRAFFE AT THE ZOO DONE BY THE CITY FORCES, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase certain building and construction materials in the open market, and also to have the work of construction of a pen or quarters for a giraffe to be located in the Municipal Zoo in William Land Park to be done by city forces, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter. The estimated cost of the completion of this work is \$3750.00.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of immediately completing and building a pen for a giraffe recently acquired by the Zoo for William Land Park. Such construction to be completed within the period of 40 days, the time when said giraffe is scheduled to arrive.
