**SUBJECT:** APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR FURNISHING AND INSTALLING COMPLETE IN PLACE FLOODLIGHTING SYSTEM TO ILLUMINATE EXISTING TENNIS COURTS AT SACRAMENTO CITY COLLEGE

SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

FINANCIAL:

In F.Y. 1979/80 the City Council approved in the Community Services Department's Budget \$65,000.00 of General funds, Park Development funds, and State Grant funds for the subject project. Total amount currently available for this project as of January 23, 1981 is \$60,934.99. The current estimated construction cost is \$46,000.00 for Item No. 1, which is for the lighting of four tennis courts and \$67,000.00 for Alternate Item, Item No. 2, which is for the lighting of eight tennis courts. Although the estimated construction cost for Alternate Item, Item No. 2 is above the amount budgeted, no budgetary recommendation will be made until bids are received and analyzed.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on March 24, 1981.
