

Resolution of Intention No. 2562

Pursuant to a law of the State of California, known as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911."

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

61ST STREET from the southerly line of 2nd Avenue to the westerly projection of the northerly line of Tahoe Terrace Unit No. 1 (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); 60TH STREET from the southerly line of Fair Way to the northerly line of 4th Avenue; 4TH AVENUE from the pavement in place on 59th Street to the center line of 61st Street; 3RD AVENUE from the easterly line of 60th Street to the westerly line of 61st Street; TAHOE WAY from the sewer in place on 59th Street to the westerly line of 61st Street; FAIR WAY from the northerly projection of the westerly line of 60th Street to the westerly line of 61st Street: by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete curbs, gutters, and sidewalks; grading and constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewers; placing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; re-setting existing gutter drains by placing same to proper grade; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; re-constructing existing manholes by placing curbs and covers to proper grade; installing street monuments; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement; and

IMPROVING THE NORTH ONE-HALF OF 5TH AVENUE from a point 117 feet easterly of the center line of 59th Street to the westerly line of 61st Street by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks where shown on plan; constructing concrete manhole complete with cast iron curb and cover; constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; placing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe, and

IMPROVING THE WESTERLY SIDE OF 61ST STREET from the westerly projection of the northerly line of said Tahoe Terrace Unit No. 1 to the northerly line of 5TH AVENUE, by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete sidewalks.

IMPROVING THE ALLEY along the northerly line of the West 170 feet of Lot 36 of Monte Vista (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), from the sewer in place in 59th Street to a point 203 feet easterly therefrom and the alley along the westerly line of Lots 7 to 10 both inclusive in Fifth Avenue Terrace (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) from a point 4 feet South of the center line of the last mentioned alley to a point 150 feet northerly therefrom and the ALLEY lying along the westerly line of Lot 49 in said Fifth Avenue Terrace, from the sewer in place in 5th Avenue to a point 160 feet northerly therefrom and the ALLEY lying along the southerly line of Lots 50 to 53 both inclusive, in said Fifth Avenue Terrace from a point 4 feet East of the last mentioned alley to a point 160 feet westerly therefrom, by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; grading and constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewers, and

IMPROVING RIGHT-OF-WAYS owned by the City of Sacramento along the rear of Lots 1 to 6 inclusive; Lots 12 and 13; Lots 15 to 22 inclusive; Lots 23 to 34 inclusive; Lots 35 to 46 inclusive; Lots 48 and 49; Lots 54 to 65 inclusive all in said Fifth Avenue Terrace, and

IMPROVING RIGHT-Of-Ways owned by the City of Sacramento common to Lots 12, 13 and 22 in said Fifth Avenue Terrace by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast iron curbs and covers; grading and constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewers.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the detailed plans therefor adopted by the City Council and now on file in the office of the City Engineer, and also in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers" heretofore adopted by the said City Council

Cast iron gutter drains shall be as shown on Cut Noll of said Specifications.

Concrete curbs and gutters shall conform to Cut No. 6 and Cut No. 13 of said Specifications, where, and as shown on the detailed plans for said improvement.

Manhole covers shall be as shown on Cut # 1B of said Specifications.

Sewer Joints shall be made with G-K-Sewer Joint Compound as specified in Section 13 of said Specifications.

Flusher Branches shall be as shown on Cut #15 of said Specifications.

Asphaltic concrete pavement shall be as shown in Section 29 of said Specifications, and

WHEREAS, said City Council has found and determined that pursuant to Section 2804 of Division 4 of the Streets and Highways Code, of the State of California, the owners of more than 85% of the area of the property subject to assessment for the above described improvement, have signed and filed with the City Clerk, a written petition, and said owners did in said petition WAIVE the proceedings required by the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931", and said City Council does hereby approve of said WAIVER and resolves to commence proceedings as provided in Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, "The Improvement Act of 1911."

And whereas, in the opinion of said City Council said work is of more than local and ordinary public benefit, said Council hereby orders that the costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be chargeable and charged upon a district of lands, which district is hereby declared to be the district benefited by said work and improvement and which is to be assessed to pay the costs and expenses thereof.

The exterior boundaries of said district and the extent of the territory included therein are shown upon the map of said district adopted and approved by the City Council on May 17, 1946, which map is now on file in the office of the City Engineer and to which reference is hereby made for a particular description of the boundaries of said district and of the extent of the territory included therein;

Saving and excepting from the above bounden and described district the area of all public streets, alleys, ways, boulevards, courts and avenues included therein.

Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," the last installment of which bonds shall mature fourteen (14) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date.

All persons objecting to said work, or to the extent of said assessment district, are required to file their objections in writing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law, and notice is hereby given to all persons interested that on the 7th day of June, 1946, at eight o'clock p. m., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall, on "I" Street, between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why the proposed work and improvement shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution twice in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law.



RESOLUTION APPROVING MAP AND DIAGRAM NO. 2562


