

RESOLUTION No. 10

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
January 19th, 1928

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT AND DETERMINING PROCEDURE OF SELECTING AN EXPERT ENGINEER TO MAKE DETAILED INVESTIGATION OF DISTRICT SEWER ALONG NORTH LINE OF WRIGHT AND KIMBROUGH TRACT NO. 33 AND 1926 BOND SEWER.

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council employ an expert engineer to make a detailed investigation of the engineering features connected with the construction of the district sewer along the north line of Wright and Kimbrough Tract No 33 also the 1926 Bond Sewer and of the materials and character of construction thereof with reference to the various contracts under which the same was constructed, having particular reference to any alterations or deviations in the said contracts, or any of them, and the estimated additional cost or reduction in cost occasioned by such alterations or deviations.

SECTION 2. RESOLVED FURTHER that the Sacramento Branch of the American Society of Civil Engineers be requested to submit to this Council the names of three qualified non-resident Engineers from which three an engineer to be employed for the above purpose may be selected.
