Per your request, information regarding radio calls, Code 12 calls, response time, and the ratio of officers per 1,000 population is submitted for your review.


Attachment I depicts the steady increase in calls the Police Department has experienced since 1971. Between 1971 and 1985, radio calls have increased 58%. As shown in Attachment II, 251,130 calls were dispatched in 1985, a 9% increase over 1984. Response time and Code 12 calls are also included in Attachment II.

Attachment III shows the ratio after 1971.



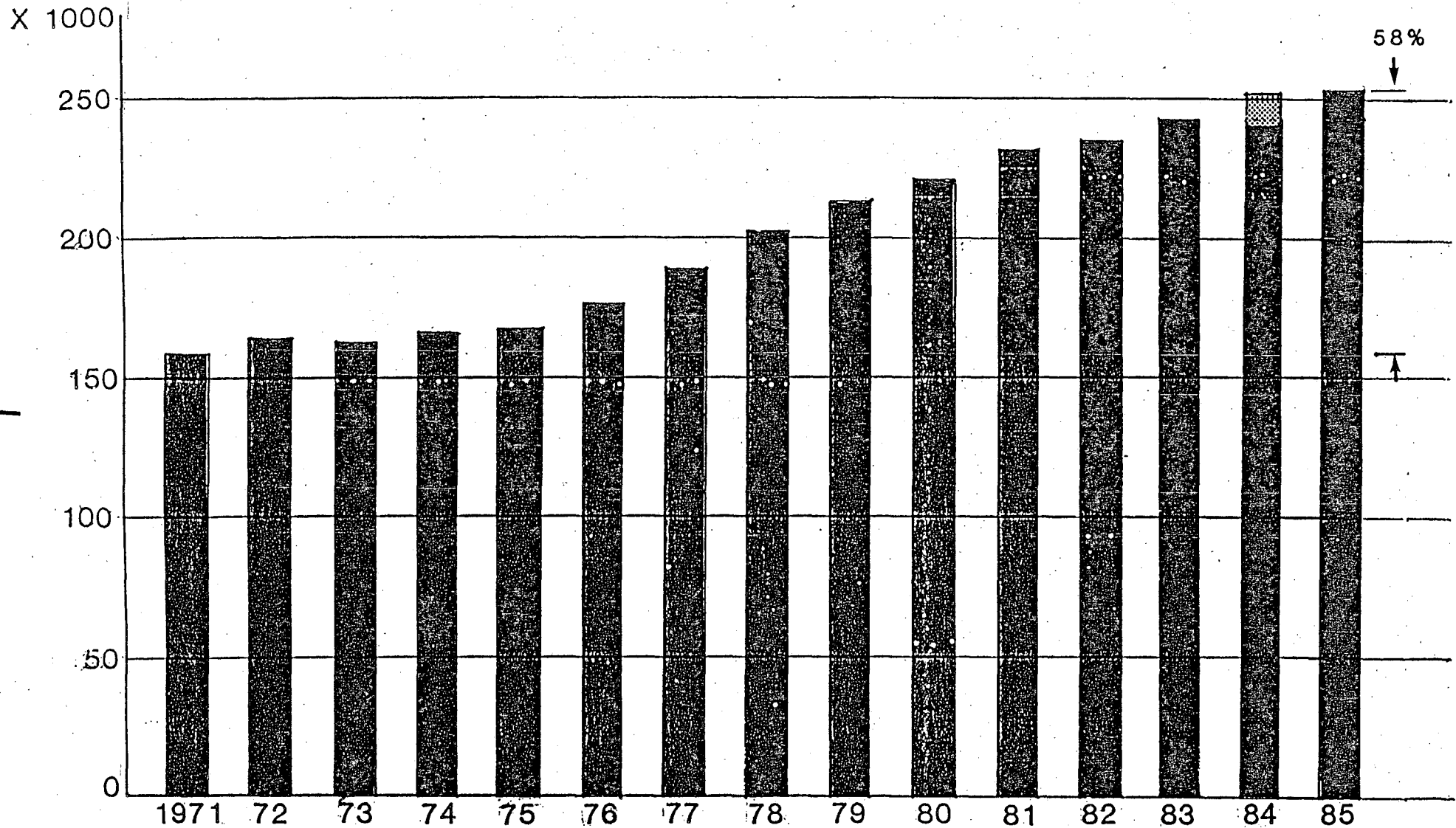
