RETIREMENT HEARING COMMISSION

David Mastagni, Attorney at Law, represented Daniel Ware, who was present. Tamara Milligan-Harmon, Deputy City Attorney represented Richard Antoine, who was present.

Ms. Harmon re-called Richard Antoine and continued direct questioning. During cross by Mr. Mastagni, Commissioner Russell informed the members that he would have to leave the meeting because of a prior commitment. It was agreed upon by all parties that the Commission would continue to hear the matter; however, the Commission would not render a decision until Mr. Russell heard the tape recording of the remaining portion of the meeting.

Mr. Russell left the meeting at 2:45 p.m.

After cross, Mr. Antoine was excused.

Mr. Mastagni presented closing arguments and submitted a Memorandum of Points and Authorities.

Ms. Harmon presented closing arguments and requested permission to submit a Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Opposition to Appellant's Motion to Reject Proposed Decision.

The attorneys' requested that transcripts of the July 6, 1987, July 16, 1987 and today's meeting be provided to the Commissioners.

At the request of the Commission, William Carnazzo, Counsel to the Commission, reviewed the issues of the motion.

It was agreed upon by all parties that this matter be continued to either October 16, 1987 or October 26, 1987 depending on Mr. Russell's schedule.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:45 p.m. to meet again at the call of the chair.
