SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Old Sacramento Handicap
Access Pedestrian Ramp and Wooden Sidewalk Reconstruction

SUMMARY

The Facility Development Section has coordinated the preparation of plans and specifications for the subject project. A copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The project consists of installing handicapped access pedestrian ramps in Old Sacramento and necessary associated reconstruction of the wooden sidewalks. The handicapped modifications are required by federal regulations.

FINANCIAL

The City Council approved \$600,000 in the adjusted FY 1985-86 budget for the subject project. There are currently sufficient funds available to complete this project, with an estimated construction cost of \$122,500.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and that bids be received on March 4, 1986.
