

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-0048

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 30, 2018

Establishing Capital Improvement Projects and Revenue and Expenditure Budgets for Improvements to Nielsen Park, Camellia Park, and Woodlake Park

BACKGROUND

- A. The California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) administers the Housing Related Parks (HRP) Program. The HRP is an innovative program designed to provide incentives to local governments that approve housing for low-income households and are in compliance with the State Housing Element law with grant funds to construct or rehabilitate parks in disadvantaged communities.
- B. The City received an award under the HRP grant program for Nielsen Park, Camellia Park and Woodlake Park in the amount of \$907,026.
- C. The grant will fund improvements to the Nielsen Park playground and tennis court, the Camellia Park tennis court, and the Woodlake Park playground.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. A new capital improvement project for Nielsen Park Playground Renovation Project (L19141500) is established.
- Section 2. A new capital improvement project for Camellia Park Tennis Court Renovation Project (L19202500) is established.
- Section 3. Establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$500,000 in Capital Grants (Fund 3704) for Nielsen Park Playground Renovation Project (L19141500).
- Section 4. Establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$100,000 in Capital Grants (Fund 3704) for Camellia Park Tennis Court Renovation Project (L19202500).

Section 5. Establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$307,026 in Capital Grants (Fund 3704) for Woodlake Park Playground Renovation Project (L19147100).
