

ORDINANCE NO. 1051 FOURTH SERIES:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1014, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 12, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1014, Fourth Series, passed July 14, 1944, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered Section 12:

Section 12: There is hereby appropriated out of the available revenues, not included in the annual 1944-45 budget, the sum of \$1600.00 for the payment of additional salaries and wages in the Hall of Justice Budget.

SECTION 2: There is hereby appropriated out of the Water Department Fund the sum of \$1672.00 for the payment of salary and wage increases in the Division of Water provided for by Ordinance No. 1026, Fourth Series.


SECTION 3: There is hereby appropriated out of the Golf Fund the sum of \$213.00 for the payment of salary and wage increases at the William Land Golf Course provided for by Ordinance No. 1026, Fourth Series.

Section 4: There is hereby appropriated out of the Golf Fund the sum of \$336.00 for the payment of salary and wage increases at the Sacramento Golf Course provided for by Ordinance No. 1026, Fourth Series.

SECTION 5: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the immediate appropriation of this money is necessary to carry on the functions of the City of Sacramento Government.
