SUBJECT: Relocation and Construction of the 12th
Green at Haggin Oaks Golf Course

SUMMARY

This report recommends Council approval to suspend competitive bidding procedures and award a contract to design and construct a replacement 12th green at Haggin Oaks Golf Course to accommodate the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District is constructing a portion of the Natomas Interceptor System within Haggin Oaks Golf Course. The interceptor alignment is designed to minimize the disruption of golf play during construction. However, the alignment will require the relocation of the 12th green of the 18-hole course at a cost estimated at \$21,000. Funds for the construction will be provided by the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District.

It is essential for the new or replacement green to be mature (ready for play) when the District's contractor begins construction within the golf course. The extremely critical time schedule makes it necessary to suspend the normal competitive bidding procedure and immediately award a construction contract for the relocated green.

FINANCIAL DATA


The construction cost for the relocated green will be provided by payment by the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District, on an advance payment-cost reimbursement basis with a maximum of \$21,000.
