

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2006-659**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 5, 2006

### **AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY AGREEMENTS, ESTABLISH RELATED REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE BUDGETS FOR THE GRANT FUNDS AND APPROPRIATE THE GRANT FUNDS CONTINGENT ON RECEIPT OF AWARD ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2006 RECREATIONAL TRIALS PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE NINOS PARKWAY PHASE III PROJECT**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Recreational Trails Program (RTP) is a competitive grant program and provides funds annually for recreational trails and trail-related projects.
- B. As part of the recent reappropriation of the Recreational Trails Program, the match requirement has been reduced from 20% of the total project budget to 12% of the total project budget. Thus, a maximum \$200,000 (88%) request will require a match of \$27,273 (12%).
- C. Matching funds for the Ninos Parkway Project will come from a grant funds secured by the City Department of Transportation and existing Capital Improvement Program funds in CIP HC61.
- C. While the City's required contribution to the proposed projects is 12% of the total project budget, those funds identified as "required match" may only be used to cover costs related to the project that are eligible under the RTP program. With some grant programs, other costs such as indirect rate charges are not eligible, therefore the City's contribution to the grant-funded project will exceed the required match amount.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Appoints the City Manager, Assistant City Manager, Director of Parks and Recreation or Support Services Manager as agent of the City of Sacramento to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.
- Section 2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary agreements, establish related revenue and expenditure budgets for the grant funds and

appropriate the grant funds contingent on receipt of award.

Section 3. Staff will return to Council if there is any significant change in requested dollar amounts, either grant or match.


