

RESOLUTION No. 5

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

WHEREAS, on April 18 1941, the City Council passed a resolution to facilitate the change from street car to bus transportation on "J" Street, from 3rd to 46th Streets, and

WHEREAS, under said resolution, the City Manager was authorized to enter into a contract with the Pacific Gas and Electric Company relative to this change, and


WHEREAS, the City Manager did enter into such contract, and

WHEREAS, because of the emergency due to the War with Japan, Germany, and Italy, the contract does not fit present conditions because of difficulties in procuring transportation equipment,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Manager be, and he is hereby, authorized to amend and modify said contract to fit present conditions.
