

RESOLUTION No. 120

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 8th, 1928.

"RESOLVED, that it is the sense of the City Council that no person or firm should circulate a petition for electrolier lighting system in the City of Sacramento in the future without first having submitted specifications of the proposed electrolier to the City Manager and have obtained his approval and the confirmation thereof of the City Council and that any petition circulated without complying with these provisions be disregarded by the City Council,

"FURTHER RESOLVED that electroliers in the residence district should have special consideration and each district be analyzed from every angle before specifications are written, thereby permitting use of a type of electrolier that will harmonize with each separate locality,

"RESOLVED FURTHER that specifications for painting of electroliers be carefully written and provide for first class waterproof job of paint."
