

ORDINANCE NO. 1055, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1014, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14, 1944, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET AS AMENDED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1944," BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO, TO BE NUMBERED SECTION 14, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1014, Fourth Series, passed July 14, 1944, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be numbered Section 14:

Section 14: (a) There is hereby appropriated, out of the sums heretofore appropriated for salaries and wages in the Health Department, the following sums:

The sum of \$500.00 for payment of the salary of a substitute plumbing inspector in the Plumbing Inspection Division;

The sum of \$10.00 for payment of salaries and wages in the Dental Clinic Division;

The sum of \$460.00 for the payment of salaries and wages in the Food & Market Inspection Division.

(b) There is hereby appropriated, out of the sums heretofore appropriated for salaries and wages in the Division of Trees for the payment of salaries and wages in the Park Department, the sum of \$500.00.

(c) There is hereby appropriated, out of the sums heretofore appropriated for salaries and wages in the Fire Department, the following sums:

The sum of \$2221.81 for the purchase of truck chassis as an Addition and Betterment in the Fire Department;

The sum of \$200.00 for the purchase of materials and supplies in the Fire Department.


(d) There is hereby appropriated, out of the sums heretofore appropriated for salaries and wages in the City Library, the sum of \$600.00 for the purchase of materials and supplies in the Library.

(e) There is hereby appropriated, out of the sums heretofore appropriated for salaries and wages in the Police Department, the sum of \$1500.00 for the purchase of materials and supplies for the Police Department.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the immediate appropriations of this money is necessary to carry on the functions of the City of Sacramento Government.
