SUBJECT: Woodlake Area Traffic Circulation Problem.

SUMMARY

This report presents information requested by the Joint Budget and Finance/Transportation and Community Development Committee at its meeting held on March 31, 1987, during which the CIP Program was reviewed.

BACKGROUND

A traffic circulation analysis will be conducted by the Traffic Engineering Section outside the framework of the Capital Improvement Program. The City normally carries out many operational analyses on a regular basis as part of its ongoing traffic investigative and traffic operational responsibilities.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Woodlake area traffic circulation analysis including the possible banning of truck traffic be conducted within the Operating Budget for 1987-88.
