

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0041

Authorizing a Project Agreement with the Department of Water Resources for the Statewide Flood Emergency Response Round 3 Grant Program

BACKGROUND

- A. The “Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006” (Proposition 84) makes funding available to improve local flood emergency response through the California Department of Water Resources.
- B. The City’s grant application was selected for funding from the Department of Water Resources for the Flood Emergency Response Project - Statewide Grant Round 3 project in the amount of \$70,000.
- C. The grant award will provide funding to address flooding issues throughout the city. There is no match requirement for the award.
- D. Approval of the Project Agreement with DWR will provide funding to address flooding issues throughout the City and allow the City to receive the amount of \$70,000 of the grant funds. The City will amend the revenue and expenditure budgets in the Ditch Repair Program (W14120600) reimbursable fund in the amount not to exceed \$70,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to:
- A. Sign the Project Agreement between the City and Department of Water Resources.
 - B. Receive funding for the Statewide Flood Emergency Response Round 3 Grant Program.
 - C. Amend the revenue and expenditure budgets in the City’s Ditch Repair Program (W14120600), for the 2018 DWR Flood Emergency Response and amend revenue and expenditure budgets as appropriate for the awarded grant funds.
