

RESOLUTION No. 117

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
November 1 1928

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MEMORIAL AUDITORIUM COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, It appears that the present rates for the rental of the Memorial Auditorium do not meet with the approval of a number of local organizations, and other restrictions governing the use of the Auditorium do not meet with approval of numbers of citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Auditorium should be operated in a manner satisfactory to the majority of the citizens, and, if possible, methods, should be found to increase its popularity and cause it to be used more frequently by local organizations, thus increasing the revenue;

NOR, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

That a Memorial Auditorium Committee of nine members be appointed by this Council, each Councilman to name one member of this Committee within ten days after adoption of this resolution, otherwise appointment shall be made by the Mayor.

It shall be the duty of this Committee to make a thorough survey of the situation and report to the City Council its recommendations covering the rental and use of the Auditorium.
