

## RESOLUTION No. 220

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of  
July 9, 1943

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 805, Statutes of 1943, the State has appropriated \$2,500,000.00 for financial assistance to local agencies carrying on civil defense activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has provided beds in the basement of the Memorial Auditorium for soldiers on leave who are unable to get sleeping accommodations; and

WHEREAS, under the act, the said City is a local agency which may apply for for an allocation from said fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that ELTON B. SHERWIN, City Manager, is hereby authorized to sign and present an application to the State on behalf of the local agency and he is also authorized and designated, as a representative, to negotiate an agreement with the State Director of Finance covering the terms and conditions under which any amount of state aid is to be granted to said City; that the amount of said aid requested is the sum of \$965.15, and it is hereby certified that funds have been paid into the City Treasury and are available for matching the amount of aid requested from the State; that the purpose for which said aid is sought is essential for adequate civilian defense, in this, that it is for the purpose of furnishing sleeping accommodations for soldiers from nearby army posts who are unable to get sleeping accommodations when on leave in said city.
