RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. ~~2511~~

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described should be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of the said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City; to-wit:

To close, vacate and abandon the following described alley: The alley between 24th Street and Western Pacific Avenue, from the southerly line of Sutterville Road to the south boundary of the City of Sacramento, being that portion of the alley in Block "B" Shoppside (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder) that lies within the City of Sacramento; reserving, however, the right of entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place in said alley or which from time to time may be placed therein. All proceedings in connection with the aforesaid closing are to be taken subject to said reservations and exceptions.

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described, and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected and benefited by said work and improvement, and that therefore the entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon, said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and the exterior boundaries of the lands affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

On the north by "Sutterville Road"; on the east by "Western Pacific Avenue"; on the west by 24th Street and on the south by the south boundary of the City of Sacramento.


And the City Council does hereby elect to proceed to do said work under the provisions of "Division 9, Part 3, Streets and Highways Code", the "Street Vacation Act of 1941", being an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, approved May 13, 1941; and hereby fixes the 23rd day of February, 1945 at 8:00 p.m. in the City Council Chamber in the Sacramento City Hall on I Street, between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place when and where any and all persons interested in said work and improvement may appear before the said City Council of said City and be heard by said City Council upon such appeal, and show cause, if any they have, why said improvement should not be made.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this resolution once in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law.
