

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-586**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council  
August 14, 2007

### **Urban Forestry Inventory Grant**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City of Sacramento has an estimated 120,000 street and parks trees. In order to effectively manage and maintain the health of the urban forest, a public tree inventory is needed.
- B. Phase 2 of the 10-phase Urban Forest Enhancement Program (CIP LX97) has been initiated. Phase 2 includes the Citywide inventory of public trees.
- C. Grant funding is available for inventory purposes through the State of California, Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, Urban Forestry Program

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The Urban Forest Services Manager is authorized to submit an application to the State of California, Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, Urban Forestry Program for an Urban Forestry Inventory Grant.
- Section 2. The Urban Forest Service Manager is authorized to execute all agreements, documents, and reports related to the Urban Forestry Inventory Grant.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to establish related revenue and expenditure budgets for the grant funds and appropriate the grant funds contingent on receipt of award.


